The MSc course aims at contributing to the circulation of knowledge and skills needed for the constitution of an all-purpose *professional profile* as expert in *Euro-Mediterranean politics* for cultural integration and dialogue, structured in the following stages and working areas (along with the respective thematic fields):

- *European citizenship as a model of social integration and freedom of movement;*
- *Immigration, social assistance and humanitarian-aid politics;*
- *European policies for development and cooperation, with particular regard to decentralised cooperation;*
- *Policies for the encouragement of intercultural dialogue;*
- *Enhancement of the cultural heritage as a factor for cohesion and economic development.*

Training activities will be carried out during two semesters and will last through **12 months**: the first semester will be devoted to base learning modules, the second to specialized ones.

These activities consist in: **frontal lectures; self-assessment tests ( at the end of each module); group practise; final paper.**

The MSc course includes **internship activities** at both public authorities and private companies.

The MSc training activities will be completed with a series of meetings arranged in partnership with Regione Lazio – Fondazione Casa delle Regioni del Mediterraneo.

The MSc activities grant **60 University Credits** that can be used in open competitions.

The application for admission to the Master must be made within the day **Wednesday, January 18th 2012** at the Masters School secretary, marketing, information and communication, and especially:

- **active European citizenship policy and development cooperation;**
- **promotion and reevaluation of cultural heritage;**
- **coordination of information and assistance services addressed to cultural mediation activities.**
